



Delegate travel guide

Arriving by plane

The nearest airports to Cambridge are:

- [London Stansted](#) just 40 minutes by car, 30 minutes on the fast [Train](#) or 50 minutes on the [National Express Coach](#).
- [London Luton](#) just 1hour 10 minutes by car or 1hour 40 minutes on the National Express Coach.

[London Heathrow](#) and [London Southend](#) are just an hour and a half drive with [London Gatwick](#) being just under 2 hours by car. The National Express Coach service and National Rail service also runs from/ to London Gatwick and London Heathrow.

[East Midlands](#) and [Birmingham Airports](#) are just as easy to get from/to by car both just taking over 2 hours. The National Express Coach service runs between Cambridge and Birmingham Airport.

Arriving by train

There are now two stations in Cambridge, Cambridge and Cambridge North.

Please ensure that you depart at Cambridge as this is the central stop.

There is a taxi rank and a bus station outside of the station. The bus services run frequently and can take you into the city centre. For the buses to the city centre and North stop opposite the station and buses heading towards Addenbrookes/South of the city are located on the same side of the Station.

Arriving by National Express Coach

The National Express coaches drop off and pick up point is along Parkside which is central. You can then walk straight into the centre from there or head to the bus station on Drummer Street, a short 5 minute walk, if you need to head out of the city.

Arriving by Car

There are numerous [car parks](#) located in Cambridge with the Grand Arcade being the most central. Other car parks can be found at the Grafton Centre, Park Street and Queen Anne Terrace on Gonville Place. We would also suggest using the Park and Ride Service if you are coming into the city centre.

Buses

Frequent buses depart and arrive at Drummer/Emmanuel Street. Up to date bus timetables can be found at the bus stops. They also state how long until the next bus. The [Park and Ride](#) service also runs frequently from five points just outside of the city, Babraham, Trumpington, Madingley, Milton and Newmarket Road.

Bicycles

A common way to get around Cambridge is by bike. There are a number of places to hire a bike from. [Rutland Cycling](#) has bikes to hire for short and long term use, available at both their Station shop and City Centre shop. [Bicycle Ambulance](#) on Park Street has bikes available to hire from just 4 hours up to two months. [City Cycle Hire](#) on Newnham Road also have bikes for short and long term hire.

Walking

Cambridge is a compact City and it is lovely to see the sights on your feet. The Station is a 25 minute walk from the city centre and the bus station is located right in the city. Look out for the maps and sign posts around the city to help guide you in the right direction.
